## HOW TO APPLY

All candidates, seeking admission should submit their applications on-line. Candidate should fill the online application form available in University website [www.kvasu.ac.in](http://www.kvasu.ac.in), uploading his/her passport size colour photograph (150WX200H pixels) and signature (250WX90H pixels). The size of photograph and signature shall not exceed 30 kb. Thereafter the candidate should make the remittance of the application fee by any of the methods, furnished below.

### a. Making payment through Demand Draft

Before filling the application, Demand Draft in favour of **Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Pookode, Wayanad** payable at **Kalpetta** for Rs. 1000/- for those belonging to General category and Rs. 500/- for SC/ST category being the application fees has to be taken from any nationalized bank. The details of Demand draft should be entered in the application form.

### b. Through credit card/debit card/Internet banking

Remit the fee at the time of submission of the application form through online payment mode using credit card/debit card/Internet banking. Candidates belonging to General Category should remit Rs.1020/- as the application fee and bank processing charges those belonging to SC/ST (Native of Kerala origin) should remit Rs. 520/-. After remitting application fee, candidate should take the print out of the fee receipt and online application form.

All candidates are requested to send the completely filled online application form along with the DD or copy of the online fee receipt after signing in the provided space of the online application with the following enclosures to the **‘The Director (Academics & Research), Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Pookode, Lakkidi P.O, Wayanad, Kerala, Pin 673576’**.

### Document to be enclosed with the application

1. Copy of the receipt if paid through Online or Demand draft if the payment of the application fee is made by Demand Draft. **Name and address of the candidate and course for which applied must be entered on the back side of the Demand Draft by pencil.** A Xerox copy of the same shall be retained by the candidate.
2. Self-attested copy of SSLC certificate or Birth certificate to prove the date of birth.
3. Self-attested copies of Certificates to prove the qualification of the candidates (Plus two/ VHSE/ Degree(both final mark list and Certificates to be provided))
4. Community Certificate obtained from a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Village Officer in the case of SC/ST candidates (Native of Kerala origin)
5. A ‘Non Objection Certificate’ and experience certificate obtained from the controlling officer concerned in the case of in-service candidates.
6. Attested copies of certificates to prove additional qualifications or extra-curricular activities like experience in job/ sports activities/ NCC/NSS etc.
7. Attested copy of nativity certificate in the case of candidates from states other than Kerala.
8. Attested copy of certificates in support of any other reservation/claims made in the application.
9. Hardcopy of the project proposal (for PhD Applicants)
10. Hardcopy of the papers published, if any (for PhD Applicants)

Incomplete applications and the application not enclosed with requisite documents will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

### PENALTY FOR FALSE INFORMATION

Any candidate who is found to have wilfully or otherwise given any particulars which are false or has suppressed material information or does not satisfy the requisite qualification for admission shall be disqualified. They shall not be allowed to continue on the rolls of the University, if it is detected at any stage of his/her studentship in the University.

## SELECTION

Selection will be from the rank list prepared by the University on the basis of the performance in the entrance test conducted by Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University.

## ENTRANCE TEST AND INTERVIEW

The candidate should download the admit card/memo from University website from 06.08.2018 to 10.08.2018. The University will not send admit card to any candidates by post. Entrance examination of one hour duration consists of multiple choice questions. Candidates will be considered for admission only if they secure a minimum of 40% marks in the entrance examination. The minimum is 30% for SC/ST candidates.

Entrance examination will be conducted at the College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Mannuthy, Thrissur (For BSc (PPBM) and Diploma programmes College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Pookode is also a centre for Entrance examination). Use of mobile phones in the examination Hall is strictly prohibited.

Candidates will be required to attend (at their own expense) the entrance test and Interview at the place and time to be notified. Candidates reporting after commencement of the examination will not be permitted to write the examination. Similarly candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall in the middle of the examination.

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

The provisional rank list of the candidates eligible for the admission to all programmes will be published in the University website. The candidates are admitted from the rank list according to the rank and communal reservation. No separate intimation letter will be sent to the qualified candidates.

## ADMISSION

The list of candidates selected for admission and the dates on which they have to remit the fees and join the course will be published at the KVASU website [www.kvasu.ac.in](http://www.kvasu.ac.in) and available for reference at the University Headquarters, Pookode, Wayanad, Kerala – 673 576. Candidates selected will be admitted to the course, provided they pay the prescribed fees in full on the due dates fixed, and produce all the relevant original certificates.

If the selected candidates fail to pay the specified fees and join the course in time, their claims for admission will be cancelled without notice and the seat thus becoming vacant will be filled up with eligible candidates, if any, in the rank/wait list.

Candidates should produce the original certificates for proof of age, qualifications, transfer certificates, conduct certificate, medical fitness certificate obtained from any Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon, Caste/Community certificate and Income certificate if seeking communal reservation, at the time of admission.

Candidates who secured their qualification from Universities/Boards outside Kerala state should produce Migration Certificate within one month after securing admission. The originals of all certificates and documents should be produced at the time of the time of admission. Those who do not produce the original documents at the time of admission, shall forfeit their seat and the seats will be filled from the waiting list or in any other manner deemed fit by the University.

Permanent discontinuation from the Programme is permitted only after remitting the entire course fee.

As ordered in G.O. MS 285/72/HD dated 6.1.1972, 10% of the total intake capacity will be reserved for SC/ST. Fractions of half or more than half in the actual working out of the percentage will be rounded off to one. List of communities to be considered under SC/ST will be as per the list approved by the Government of Kerala.

## EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF FEES

Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates of Kerala state may be given exemption from payment of fees subject to the grant of concession by the Scheduled Caste Development Department, Government of Kerala. However, they will have to pay various caution deposits. They should also submit applications for concession in the prescribed form. The High Court of Kerala will be the only judicial body to decide on the disputes arising if any, in the matter of admissions.

The prospectus is subject to further modification/addition as may be considered necessary by the University and will be issued as executive orders/notifications and the students are liable to obey the rules and regulations so amended or modified. Dress code of the students shall observe dress code prescribed by the institution and shall be intimated to them at the time of admission.

## HOSTEL FACILITIES

Hostel facilities are limited and will be provided to students, as per the availability of accommodation in the campus. Those who do not secure Hostel accommodation in the campus shall make their own arrangements outside. Students admitted will not have any claim for hostel facilities in both the campuses. University does not undertake to provide such facility by way of this prospectus.
